Market Day

- Stay home if sick
- Set-up is between 7:00 AM and 9:30 AM
- Ready to sell by 9:30am
- Vehicles arriving after 9:30am will not be allowed to drive onto the site
- Stall spaces are sent out the week of each Market
 - Spray painted on ground
 - 6 feet apart
- All vendors drive onto the grass and unload
- Market vendors are responsible for supplying your own canopies, ground covering, 20lbs (or more) tent weights on each tent leg. and any other materials that you need

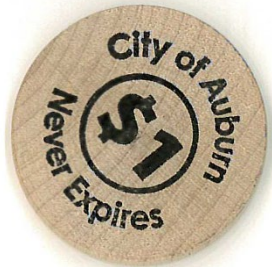
Market Day

 - Handwash station set up
 - Temp. of water in handwash station
 - Hands washed in booth – water in bucket
 - Food/sneeze covers
 - No bare hand contact
 - Temperature Checks
- King Co. Health Department twice a season
 - Food handlers permit
 - Exemption Permit
 - Temporary Event Permit
 - Mobile Permit

- We will still accept EBT

 - \$1 increments

Sprouting Seeds



Materials:

- Ziplock bag
- Lima Beans
- Coffee Filter

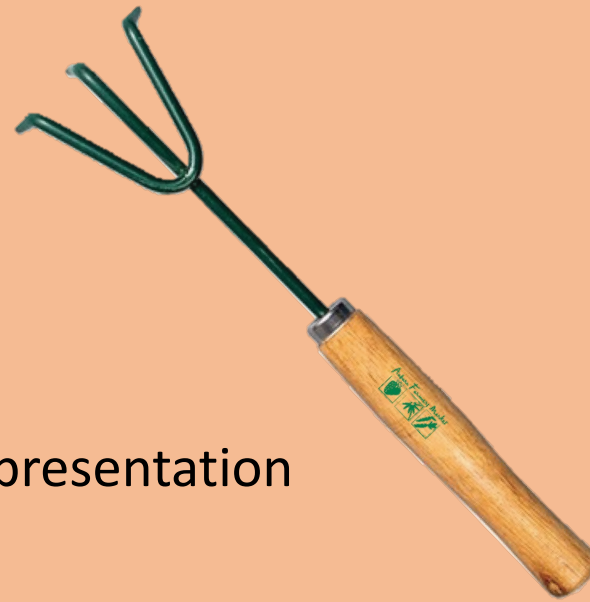
Instructions

- Dampen the coffee filter
- Lay seeds on the filter and space them out
- Fold the filter over the seeds to keep the moisture all around the seeds
- Place in a plastic bag
- Put the plastic bag in a warm place and keep the towel damp until the seeds sprout.
- Leave your seeds to sprout, check on them occasionally to see if they need more water
- When you see the roots forming, open your coffee filters to give your sprouts room to grow
- Once leaves or a shoot start to form you can replant your sprouts in soil
