Properly dispose of your household hazardous waste at the King County Wastemobile for FREE. Household Hazardous Waste includes oil-based paint, stains, household cleaners, pesticides, motor oil, antifreeze, and more. Location: The Outlet Collection, 1101 Outlet Collection Way, Auburn.
The collection facility is on the backside of the mall by Nordstrom Rack. Open every Saturday and Sunday from 10am-5pm.

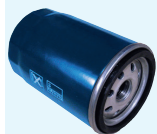


Home Collection:

Are you a King County or Pierce County Auburn resident 65 or older, or a resident with disability? If you do not have a vehicle or are otherwise unable to access a hazardous waste collection site, you can call the Haz Waste Help Line (206-296-4692) to schedule a waste pickup at your home.

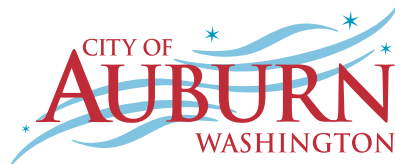

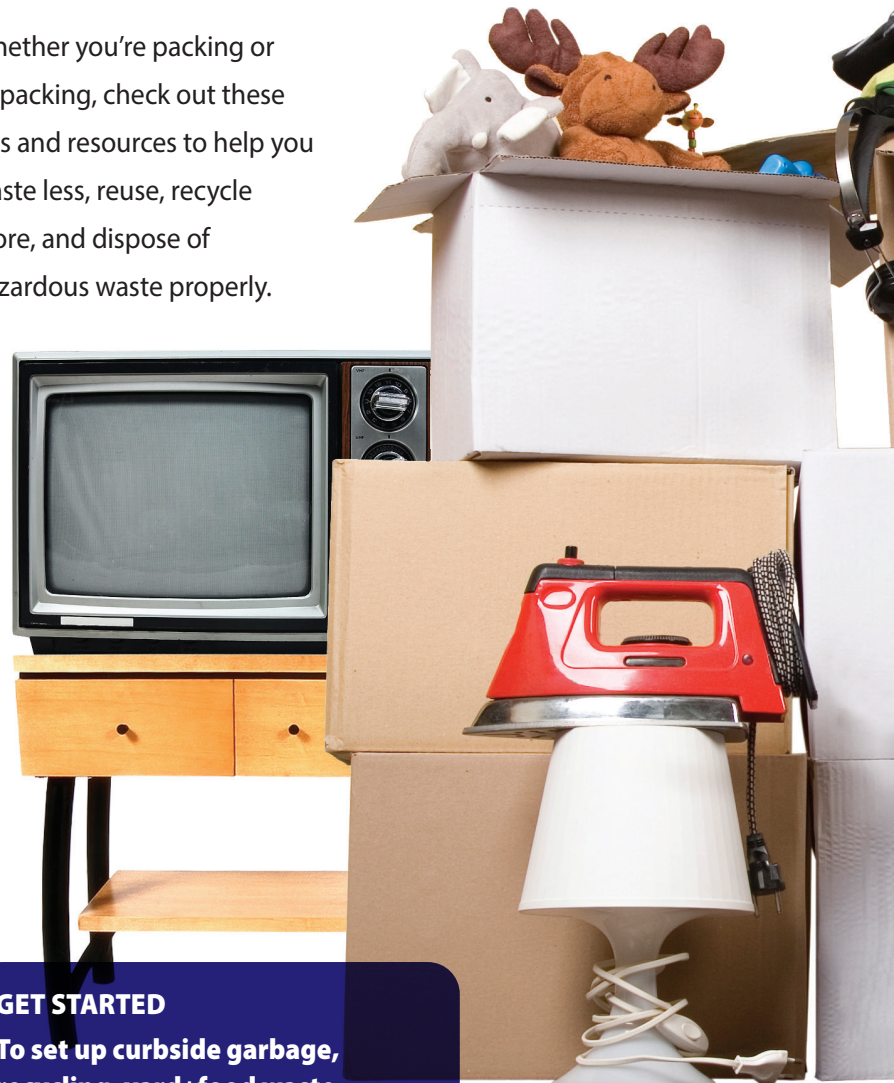

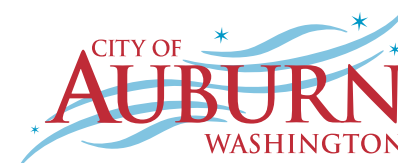
Whether you're packing or unpacking, check out these tips and resources to help you waste less, reuse, recycle more, and dispose of hazardous waste properly.

PACK IT UP

- **Need moving boxes?** Instead of buying new, check for used boxes in your area on www.Craigslist.org, www.Freecycle.org or a local moving company.
- **Reuse what you've got.** Use luggage and containers you already own to pack belongings.
- **Rent reusable moving containers** from companies like FrogBox, www.frogbox.com, 1-877-376-4269.
- **Wrap fragile items** in towels or small linens, reused bubble wrap or use newspaper and recycle it after the move.



CLEAN IT OUT

Transfer station: Dispose of old, larger furniture and household items that are not reusable or recyclable at the King County Transfer Station, 35315 W. Valley Hwy, Algona, 206-477-4466.

Extra garbage put out for collection above the normal service level for your home will be charged an additional fee. Save money and do the right thing by reusing and recycling as much as possible.

RECYCLE RIGHT

There are many options for recycling your household items. Always call a business to verify what they accept and if there are any charges to recycle your items.

Moving Boxes (free):

Flatten and recycle in your curbside cart. If they won't fit in the cart, put in a box or can, label "RECYCLE", and they will be collected at no extra charge. DO NOT use plastic bags. Maximum cardboard size: 2 ft. x 3 ft. flattened.

Electronics (free):

Recycle computers, laptops and tablets, monitors, TVs, e-readers, portable DVD players.

Cooking Oil (free):

Recycle used cooking oil.

- Les Gove Park (south of water spray park), 910 9th St SE, open during daylight hours.
 - Used cooking oil only (no motor oil)
 - Pour cooled, cooking oil over grated. top into tank mark "General Biodiesel".
 - Close lid.
 - Take containers home.
 - Leave area clean.
